Asian Composers League Young Composer Competition 2018

Deadline date: Monday, 18 June, 2018 [Delivery Deadline]

Date held: 19-23 October 2018

Entry restriction: Australian composers born after 19 Oct, 1987

Further Details

Australian composers under the age of 30 are invited to submit scores for the Asian Composers League Young Composer Competition. The competition forms part of the 35th Asian Composers League (ACL) Festival & Conference in Taiwan, 19–23 October 2018. There are monetary prizes of US\$500, \$300 and \$200, but more important is the chance to have a festival performance and to be able to travel there and meet other composers.

The Melbourne Composers' League will select one young composer to represent Australia at the upcoming festival's competition. Composers should be Australian citizens, or permanent residents, and born after 19 October 1987. The work should be written for a duet of two heterogeneous instruments, from the following two groups respectively: Group A: Violin, Viola, Violoncello and Double Bass; Group B: Flute/Picc, Oboe, Bb/A Clarinet and Bassoon. The piece must be no more than 8 minutes in duration with a maximum of 2 performers.

The score, along with the title of the work, the composer's name in English on the cover and the following information (a–k) must be submitted. The information should be written in English and, where applicable, Chinese names should include the equivalent Chinese ideographs.

3. The score, along with the title of the work, the composer's name in English on the cover and the following information (a–k) must be submitted. The information should be written either in English.

- a. Name
- b. Nationality, date of birth(copy of the passport)
- c. Address, telephone number, fax number, e-mail address
- d. Title of the work
- e. Year composed
- f. Duration, instrumentation
- g. Biography of composer (maximum 150 words)
- h. Program notes (maximum 150 words)
- i. Has the work been performed? If yes, where?
- j. CD or audio tape of the work (if available)
- k. Photo of the composer

A total of US\$1,000 cash prizes will be given to up to 3 winners. Winner of the first prize will be invited to write a new piece to be premiered during the next ACL festival (no additional commission fee is involved). The Vietnam Musicians' Association will provide hotel accommodation for the young composers for the duration of the festival.
